Assignments

There is one written project - a practical risk assessment.
If specific questions are asked about the content of the project, or the person does not meet the standard, answers/comments provided within 3 working days. No written feedback given on projects submitted for final evaluation as IOSH do not allow this or marks given to be fed back.

Exam

Yes. There is one invigilated, closed book, 25 multiple choice question exam (45 minutes). Exam date is set and invigilated within the prison so can be taken at any time. Available all year round.
