Assignments	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Activities are provided for each of the 9 syllabus elements, which can be self-marked. • Mock exam provided for exam practice. Feedback is typically provided within 2 weeks.
Exam	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Assessment is by an open book written exam carried out over 24 hours and a practical assessment comprising an assessment of environmental aspects and impacts of a workplace. • The open book exam should take approximately 5 hours and the practical assessments approximately 4 hours • Exams are scheduled by NEBOSH quarterly.
