Structure of course

- 1. Create a 7-day food diary based on an individual's activity
- 2. Analyse the results
- 3. Produce a set of goals to improve the individual's dietary practices

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Assignments	There is a single worksheet and case study document to complete and submit. They are sent at the start of the course. They can be sent at the same time where possible but can be completed separately if preferred. Course work will be marked with 7-days of receipt by post/email.
Exam	One multiple choice exam (15-minute) including 10 questions. The exam is available all-year round. Exam fees are included in the course cost.
