Exam	<p>Assessment is by a written exam and a practical assessment.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The exam is open book. 2. The practical assessment is a workplace-based fire risk assessment. 3. The exam is run over 24 hours. <p>Exam fees are included in the cost of the course (paid by the trust).</p>
