

## Transport Manager Certificate of Professional Competence (CPC)

### Summary

If you wish to become a transport manager or an owner/operator in the commercial transport industry, this qualification is essential. The course covers the civil, commercial, social and fiscal law associated with haulage, as well as providing information on business and financial management, access to the market, technical standards and road safety.

<b>Exam</b>	two external exams. They can only be taken at a regional exam centre after release, or on ROTL if prison support it. Two papers each of 2 hours 30 minutes duration, in each paper. They are open book and involve Multiple choice questions, short questions, an essay type question, and a case study question. Exam fees are not included in the course cost. You can apply to PET to cover the exam cost by submitting an EEE application form. Speak to your distance learning coordinator for more information.

	<p>In the community exams can be sat every March, June, September and December. Exam entry deadlines are 3 weeks before the exam. Exams must be sat at a CPC approved centre. EP is an approved centre for Leatherhead, Surrey. For other locations we advise you contact the Skills and Educations Awards. Results are sent 6 weeks after exams are sat.</p> <p>Refer to 'Prison support requirements'</p>
